Toronto News Canadian Election

The month of October is a busy month this year in Canada. First we have Thanksgiving, then a Federal Election, and then Halloween. Every four years in Canada, a Federal election is held. This is when all the people in the country vote for the prime minister of Canada. This is a major party of what makes a democratic country so great. The people of the country of choose who runs the country and what kind of future we want for ourselves.

Canada has six major parties that have different goals for Canada's future. The major parties in Canada are: the Liberal Party of Canada, the Conservative Party of Canada, the New Democratic Party (NDP), the Bloc Quebecois (the Bloc), the Green Party of Canada, and the Peoples' Party of Canada (PPC). Sometimes there is an independent person who wants to try to be part of government, but doesn't believe in any of the six parties' ideas and goals. Each party has a leader. This person is someone the political party has chosen to be the Prime Minister if the party gets the most votes. For example, Canada's current political party is the Liberal Party and the leader of that party is Justin Trudeau. Thus, Justin Trudeau is the Prime Minister of Canada.

The country is broken into spaces called riding. There are 338 riding. Each riding has a representative for a political party (the Liberals, the Conservatives, the NDP, the Bloc, the Green's, the PPC, or an independent) that Canadian can vote for. Each Canadian can vote only once. The party that gets the most number of votes in a riding wins. When all is said and done, the party with the most won ridings will be the next governing body of Canada. When Canada votes on October 21st 2019 the government and prime minister will be decided.

General English - ESL (English as a Second Language)

SGIC offers 6 different levels of ESL classes to learn in: ESL 1 – ESL 6. In the morning, students learn reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills with grammar mixed into the lessons. This allows grammar to make more sense to our students and helps create real life connections between the classroom and how you will use your knowledge outside of the classroom.
