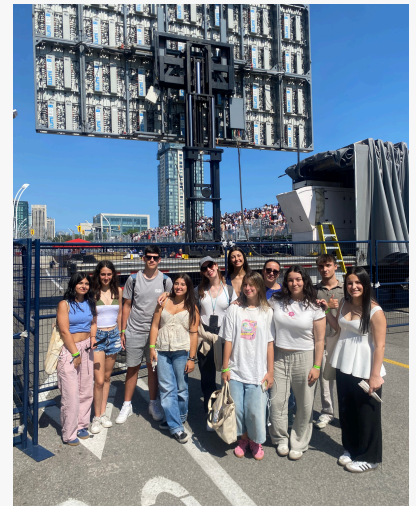
A Vibrant Start to Summer at SGIC with Our Spanish Summer Camp Students!
